Here are a few of our recommendations and favourites in the local area...



HOP-ON HOP-OFF BUSES

Enjoy a hop-on hop-off, open-top sightseeing bus tour of London and discover the landmarks and stories of this dynamic and historic city.



OLD SPITALFIELDS MARKET, SPITALFIELDS

As London's oldest market, Spitalfields is a must-visit when in London with your four-legged friend. Open seven days a week, trawl through the stalls alongside Fido – from contemporary and vintage fashion, homemade children's toys, jewellery and accessories, and homeware – you're sure to find some fabulous buys! As the market is undercover, come rain or shine Spitalfields makes for a great day out, and there are many of places to sit and eat with your pet.



ST JAMES'S PARK, WESTMINSTER

Considered the most beautiful royal park in London, St James's Park is a truly fabulous place to visit with your pet. Spanning over 58 acres, walk round the park's lake to see the resident ducks, geese and pelicans –and the spot where Joely Richardson and Jeff Daniels' characters were careered into the lake by their dogs in the live-action version of 101 Dalmatians.

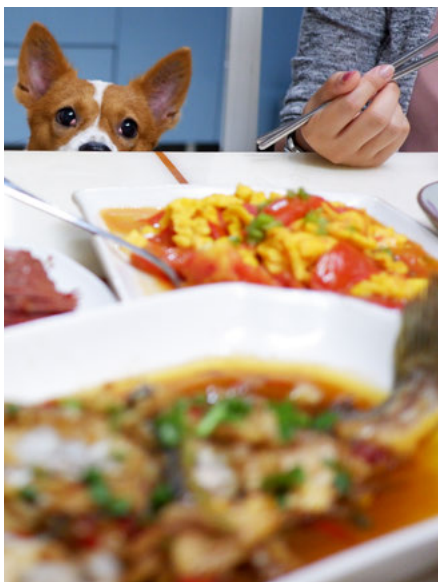




THE BIKE SHED

384 Old Street, EC1V 9LT

One of the best hidden gems in Shoreditch, The Bike Shed is a unique space for hungry patrons and pups. Not only boasting a dog-friendly barbers alongside 12,000 square feet of bike space in cool railway arches, dogs are welcome in the restaurant with diners.



DUCK AND RICE

90 Berwick Street, W1F 0QB

Curl up with your pup on the ground floor of Duck and Rice, where you'll be welcomed with water, treats and plenty of special care. One of the very few Chinese restaurants in London that welcomes dogs, this Soho spot will fill humans up with duck, dim sum and creative dishes.



GAUCHO BROADGATE

5 Finsbury Avenue, EC2M 2PG

Upmarket Argentinian steak restaurant Gaucho has its own doggy menu, The Muttropolitan, alongside a dog policy which means pups are allowed all day between 12pm - 6pm. Their 'Doggy Sundays' let you book a table under your pooch's name, and waiters will offer treats and entertainment for them, including a doggy bag of treats and surprises to take home.

Pet Policy

We are pleased to have you and your pet as our guests at Pan Pacific London. As a service to you, we have outlined a few simple guidelines that will help ensure the comfort and safety of yourself and our other guests whilst visiting our hotel.

Pets must not be left unattended in guestrooms.

When outside your guestroom, pets must be on a leash. You are responsible for cleaning up after your pet whilst on property, and this is also a requirement across London. Waste bags are available at Concierge.

Please dial Guest Services to co-ordinate daily Housekeeping service. It is often far more convenient for you and your pet to have your room serviced while you are both out.

You are responsible for any and all property damage and/or personal injuries resulting from your pet. If as a result of your pet's residency, the hotel is required to provide a third party with any form of compensation, the value of the compensation is your responsibility. The value of the compensation decided by the Hotel is non-negotiable and does not require any pre-approval from you as the pet owner.

Guestrooms can accommodate a maximum of two pets per room, at a maximum weight of 15kg each. A charge of £60 inclusive of VAT per pet per stay applies for the accommodation of your pet. You must further agree to indemnify and hold harmless the hotel, its owners and its operators from all liability and damage suffered as a result of your pet. The Hotel will also pass on all charges incurred to repair any damages caused by your pet.

Pet Accessible Areas

We know you and your four-legged friends want to be together as much as possible during your stay. However, there are a few restrictions to where your pets are allowed as we want all guests to feel comfortable during their stay with us.

GINGER LILY LOUNGE

Pets are allowed in Ginger Lily Lounge, however dogs must be kept on a tight leash while cats must be in a cat carrier.

GINGER LILY BAR

Pets are only allowed on the Ginger Lily Bar terrace.

STRAITS KITCHEN

Pets are allowed in Straits Kitchen, however dogs must be kept on a tight leash while cats must be in a cat carrier.

SENSORY SPA & WELLBEING

Please note, pets are not allowed in this area.

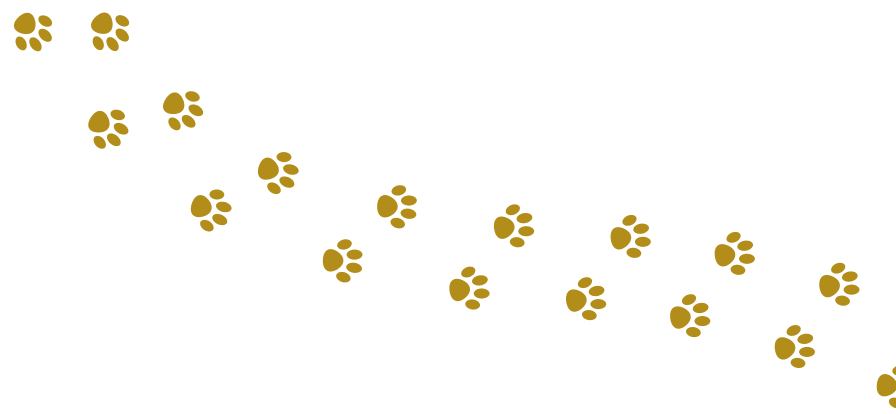
